

The United States International Searching Authority (ISA/US) refuses entry of proposed replacement drawing sheets 1/18 - 18/18, because they contain changes that cannot be construed as rectifications of an obvious error within the meaning of PCT Rule 91.1. For example:

Sheets 3/18, 4/18, 6/18, 8/18, 9/18, 12/18, 13/18 and 15/18 (Figs. 1C, 3A, 4, 5B, 5C, 7A, 7B, 8A and 8B) - figures are not illustrated identical to that originally filed.

All other sheets are not numbered consecutively.

Obvious mistakes may be corrected before the United States International Searching Authority (ISA/US) in accordance with PCT Rule 91.1(c), which provides that "The competent authority shall authorize the rectification under this Rule of a mistake if, and only if, it is obvious to the competent authority that, as at the applicable date under paragraph (f), something else was intended than what appears in the document concerned and that nothing else could have been intended than the proposed rectification." In the present case, the changes proposed above are not rectifications of obvious mistakes permitted under Rule 91.1(c) as it is not obvious that what is offered as rectification is what was specifically intended as originally filed.

Note that during Chapter I proceedings, changes to the description, claims and drawings may only be entered upon approval by the International Searching Authority if the changes comply with Rule 91.1(c). However, applicant may submit these changes for consideration as an amendment under PCT Article 34 along with the Demand when entering Chapter II under the provisions of the Patent Cooperation Treaty, or by submitting the changes upon entry in the National Stage. The amendments may only be entered if they do not go beyond the disclosure of the international application as filed. Additionally, Article 34 amendments submitted during Chapter II must also be in compliance with PCT Rules 11.14 and 66.
